CHARGING and REMISSIONS POLICY

The following policy will be reviewed by the Resources Committee annually.

The governing body will:

- Make charges as allowed by the Education Act (this includes music tuition, board and lodging on residential trips, attendance at Breakfast Club and participation in some after school activities). All requests for charges to be waived on the basis of general financial hardship will be considered by the Executive Headteacher or Head of School providing the request is made before the event
- Seek voluntary contributions from parents so that activities during school hours, for which charges may no longer be mandated, can continue. It will be made clear to parents that such contributions are voluntary, but that such activities may not go ahead unless sufficient monies are received

All requests will be considered in cases of general hardship
